### Recipe for Chocolate Chip

#### Cookie

#### Wet Ingredients:

- 1 Cup- Unsalted Butter (room temp.)
- 1 Cup- White Sugar
- 1 Cup- Brown Sugar
- 2 Eggs
- 2 Teaspoons- Vanilla Extract

#### Dry Ingredients:

- 1/2 Teaspoon- Salt
- 1 Teaspoon- Baking Soda
- 1 Teaspoon - Baking Powder
- 3 Cups- Flour
- 2 Cups- Chocolate Chips

#### Directions:

1. Have two separate bowls, one for wet ingredients and the other for dry ingredients.
2. In the wet ingredients bowl put all of the wet ingredients into it. Mix after every ingredient.
3. Set your wet mixture aside and grab another bowl for your dry ingredients.

- You will then add all the dry ingredients.
4. Mix the dry ingredients into the wet ingredients and mix fully until the batter is brown.
  5. Finally add the chocolate chips and mix until the chocolate chips are incorporated all over the batter.
  6. Put the batter into the fridge for an 1 hour
  7. Make batter into same size balls and put them in a baking sheet.
  8. Preheat the oven to 350F and bake cookies for 10-12 minutes until golden brown.


